

Independent at Home Assistive Technology

Assistive technology enables people with disabilities succeed at work and in school, stay active and involved in the community, and maintain independence. Paraquad's Assistive Technology program removes barriers and helps individuals live well with greater independence.

Assistive technology is any item, piece of equipment, software or product system used to increase, maintain, or improve the functional capabilities of people with disabilities.

Assistive Technology Reuse Program:

The Assistive Technology Reuse Program provides used durable medical equipment to people with disabilities. Paraquad also accepts donations of used equipment and offers it for open ended loans.

Missouri's Telecommunication Access Program:

Missouri's Telecommunication Access Program provides equipment to qualifying people with disabilities who need assistance accessing the telephone or internet.

Assistive Technology Demonstration Center:

The Assistive Technology Demonstration Center offers a universally designed apartment to demonstrate low- and high-tech assistive technology. People with disabilities, family members, and professionals can explore and make informed decisions about what assistive technology is right for them.
